The following specific statements, actions, or facts give rise to a reasonable fear of significant dangerous acts by the respondent: On 08/14/2022 at approximately 1100 hours, Deputies responded to the intersection of Deleon Springs, in reference to a disturbance. Prior to arrival, VSO Central Communications advised a female, identified as contacted and advised her son, (V1) had a firearm pointed in his face by a neighbor. detailed the neighbor as (S1), and further advised their family has had prior issues with 2 Additional pages are attached. provided the following 2. {Name of Witness} information based on his/her personal knowledge: advised that after his truck became stuck in the culvert, approached him, fired a round into the air, and subsequently held the barrel of his gun to advised he observed finger on the trigger, and was in a well-founded fear was going to cause him great bodily harm. Upon initial arrival, Deputy Morgan made contact with whom was partially concealed in the woods southwest of the intersection, and ordered him to show his hands and walk towards Deputy Morgan. So however refused and retreated down a dirt trail to his residence informing Deputy Morgan he was going inside and "did not want to deal with this." Due to being in possession of firearms, and being located at his residence not in any further danger, Deputy Morgan made the decision to await further resources at the intersection behind hard cover.
Due to spickup truck blocking the only form of ingress/egress onto their road, phone contact was made with spickup by Deputy Morgan. So advised survived home and informed her of the following: that while attempting to turn down truck became stuck in the culvert along the roadway. At that point, sentered the roadway from his property which sits on the southwest corner of the intersection and confronted about ruining the culvert. During this confrontation, advised produced two pistols, fired a round into the air, then stuck the gun barrel up against his temple, stating that he would kill and his family. Stated at that point his body's flight-or-fight response kicked in, and he ran from the immediate area towards his residence on advised they wished to pursue criminal charges against on behalf of
Once additional Deputies arrived, a perimeter was established and Sgt. Charles requested the assistance of Air 1 and a drone unit whom both subsequently responded to the area. The Weekend Watch Commander, Lt. Barnard, was also made aware of the incident and responded to the scene. Deputies attempted PA system announcements, ordering to surrender and speak with Deputies, however no response was received from Approximately three hours after arriving on scene, the pickup truck was able to safely be removed from the culvert by and the road became re-accessible.
