On August 23, 2023 at approximately 2356 hours Deputies responded to Deltona in reference to a mentally ill person.
Prior to Deputies arrival, Central Dispatch advised (V1) called 911 stating he had PTSD which was triggered by stress. Advised he was reaching out for help and did not have any weapons. Upon Deputies arrival, they made contact with putside of his residence. Appeared intoxicated but was cooperative with Deputies. Advised the following information:
He was lonely and stressed by work related issues. During the conversation repeatedly mentioned that he was thinking of putting a bullet in his head. stated he called 911 for help instead of shooting himself in his head, and that Deputy Gourley saved his life by coming to speak with him.
Based on the totality of the circumstance, Deputy Langdon determined there is a substantial likelihood that without care or treatment, would likely cause serious bodily harm or death to himself in the near future, as evidenced by his recent behavior and statements. Therefore, was placed into protective custody under the Baker Act guidelines. Deputies secured in handcuffs without incident.
Deputy Gourley transported to the Stewart Marchman Act (SMA) healthcare center located at 1150 Red John Drive, Dayton Beach. Deputy Gourley completed the Report of Law Enforcement Officer Initiating Involuntary Examination Form and the Baker Act Transport Form and provided them to SMA staff. was released to the custody of SMA staff.
