On 12/03/2023, at approximately 1745 hours, deputies responded to  New Smyrna Beach, for a male experiencing a manic episode with an altered mental state, and was attempting to leave the home with a firearm. The caller,  (O1) advised her husband,  V1) was the subject suffering the manic episode. While units were responding, dispatch advised a verbal argument started between and his adult son,  (O2) over dropping the firearm.

Once deputies arrived on the scene, was on the ground being held down by his son, and the firearm was no longer in a spossession. Once was secured in handcuffs behind his back, he requested medical attention, advising he suffered a back injury from being pushed to the ground and laid on by requested to stay lying on his stomach due to his back hurting and the possibility of a back injury.
Deputies interviewed both and about the incident, and both were willing to provide sworn written statements about the incident.
According to the family, seems and been sleep-deprived for the last 3 weeks due to hunting season. Suffers from bipolar disorder and has been taking medication regularly until today. According to Laura, seems medication recently changed and she believed the change is what caused the manic episode. Stated the family took measures to lock up all firearms in a separate room to keep them away from out of fear that would harm himself. Wooke up today, 12/03/2023, in a manic and paranoid state. Began an argument with and started beating on the walls inside the home and breaking down walls within the home. Cut a hole in a wall that connects to a room where the family stores the firearms, grabbed a high-caliber rifle, and started loading up his vehicle as if to go hunting. As was loading the vehicle, surfaced on the scene to help the A verbal argument began between and while they were attempting to calm down. According to the family, they believed the firearm was loaded and were worried would hurt himself. Successfully took the gun from and was able to restrain on the ground until deputies arrived, hen stated he injured his back and believed it was broken.

For approximately 45 minutes while deputies were on scene and observing made several bizarre statements. Called a deputy "white boy", was singing songs, yelling about needing a cow bell, and said he had a fever additionally made statements of "don't use a small caliber gun on a large caliber man" and "that mother fucking nigger is gonna shoot me in the head." and "I wanna look pretty for the boys."
Once emergency medical personnel arrived on scene, appeared to have a small skin tear on his left forearm. Deputies and medical personnel were not able to see any other physical injuries.
Through Deputy Peas' investigation it was determined there would be a substantial likelihood that without the proper care or treatment, would likely cause serious bodily harm to himself or others. was taken into protective custody under the Baker Act and was later transported to Halifax Hospital by EVAC for treatment and medical attention.
and advised they were not in fear of at any point during the incident.  and agreed to remove all the firearms from the home as a safety precaution. Photographs of the firearm had were taken and submitted in Digital Crime Scene. An RPO was completed by Deputy Peas.
