FROM SECTION 1 & 2

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On 05/31/2026 at approximately 1800 hours, Deputies were dispatched to a report of a suicidal person at _____ Deltona. Dispatch notes indicated a male was being held on the ground after attempting to obtain a firearm to commit suicide.

Deputies arrived and secured _____ (S1), who was still erratic and combative upon law enforcement arrival. Deputies noticed _____ had bleeding injuries and notified medical personnel immediately. Also in the home were _____ wife, _____ (O1) and _____ brother, _____ (O2).

_____ stated that earlier today _____ became upset because he found empty liquor bottles along his property line and blamed it on _____ relatives that live nearby. _____ stated she was dismissing _____ angered statements, which made _____ very upset. _____ stated _____ threatened to divorce her, and again _____ said she was dismissive. _____ stated that this threw _____ into a fit of rage. _____ stated _____ got into his pickup truck and drove recklessly up and down the road until he stopped back into the driveway and then drove into the side of their detached garage causing significant damage to their truck and garage. _____ stated that _____ was injured in the crash and he crawled into the house, making suicidal statements. _____ stated _____ said he was going to go get one of their firearms and kill himself, which were locked in a safe. _____ said hearing this, _____ physically restrained _____ while _____ notified law enforcement.

_____ had a similar account of events. _____ is staying with _____ and _____ for several weeks and was present when the entire incident occurred.

Deputies made observations that _____ was likely under the influence of alcohol during the incident.

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AFFIDAVIT CONTINUATION

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Based on the physical and anecdotal evidence, accompanied with [REDACTED] current mental state, it was apparent that without immediate law enforcement intervention that [REDACTED] was likely to harm himself or others preventing him from harming himself. Deputy Martin placed [REDACTED] into custody under a Baker Act. Due to the severity of [REDACTED] injuries, he was transported via Deltona Rescue personnel to Advent Fish Memorial Hospital in Sanford. Nurse [REDACTED] at Advent Fish Memorial Hospital accepted custody of [REDACTED] under the Baker Act.

Due to their being firearms present in the home, Deputy Martin determined it was necessary to file an affidavit to petition for a Risk Protection Order and develop a temporary plan to relocate the firearms. [REDACTED] indicated she was going to collect the firearms she was aware about and transport them to a family members home who could safely secure them.

Deputies did not collect any firearms or document any firearms on scene.
