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AFFIDAVIT CONTINUATION

FROM SECTION 1

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BWC RECORDING

On Friday, 06/19/2026, at approximately 2347 hours, deputies responded to [REDACTED], Deltona, in reference to a fight with injuries. Prior to arriving on scene, Deputy Prado reviewed the call notes which advised the reporting person, [REDACTED] (V1), was jumped by his brother along with someone else and one of them took his firearm. Additionally, the call notes advised [REDACTED] brother was pointing the firearm at him.

Upon arrival to the scene, K9 Deputy Richardson and Deputy Prado made contact with [REDACTED] outside of the residence. It became apparent upon making contact that he appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. [REDACTED] eyes were watery and red, he had slurred speech, struggled to maintain balance and the odor of alcoholic beverages could be detected emanating from his breath. [REDACTED] was found to be in possession of an extended magazine to a Glock pistol and a holster, which were both in his pockets.

[REDACTED] stated he was invited over by his brother, [REDACTED] (W1) to watch the FIFA World Cup. [REDACTED] explained while he was in the living room watching soccer, him and [REDACTED] decided to have a conversation inside of [REDACTED] vehicle. According to [REDACTED] while they were talking, [REDACTED] for no apparent reason at all, began to attack him. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] stole his firearm, a Glock 23, from his body and then threatened to shoot him with hit.

Deltona Fire Rescue responded to the scene to treat [REDACTED] for a laceration to his lip however [REDACTED] declined to be treated.

Deputy Prado then made contact with [REDACTED] outside of his residence. [REDACTED] explained to Deputy Prado that he invited [REDACTED] over to watch the FIFA World Cup. [REDACTED] advised while they were watching the game, [REDACTED] girlfriend and children were in their rooms respectively preparing for bed. [REDACTED] explained while him and [REDACTED] were sitting in the living room, [REDACTED] started making concerning statements about his wellbeing. [REDACTED] not wanting his family to listen to what was being said by [REDACTED] encouraged [REDACTED] to continue the conversation in [REDACTED] car, which was parked in the driveway of the residence. According to [REDACTED] while sitting in the car, [REDACTED] pulled out a firearm, a Glock 23 pistol and began telling [REDACTED] "I could end it all right now. It could all be over." [REDACTED] fearing what [REDACTED] might do, advised he forcibly removed the firearm from [REDACTED] grip which quickly led to him and [REDACTED] fighting for control of the firearm within the car.

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[REDACTED] noted while he was fighting for the firearm, he may have made incidental contact with [REDACTED] causing him to suffer a laceration on his lip. [REDACTED] explained after he successfully gained possession of the firearm, he exited the vehicle and [REDACTED] continued in his efforts to obtain his firearm. [REDACTED] advised he was able to keep [REDACTED] away and the firearm was hidden from him inside of the residence. It should be noted [REDACTED] explained at no point did [REDACTED] ever point the firearm in his direction, nor threaten to use it against him.

[REDACTED] explained to Deputy Prado that [REDACTED] has a history of making suicidal statements whenever he is under the influence of alcohol. [REDACTED] declined to complete a sworn written statement but was sworn to his oral statement.

Deputy Prado reinterviewed [REDACTED] and asked him to clarify what happened inside of the car. [REDACTED] stated he said something about "family" which upset [REDACTED] leading to [REDACTED] beating up [REDACTED] inside of the vehicle. When Deputy Prado asked why he would make statements about "ending it all" inside of the car while in possession of a firearm, there was a noticeable change in [REDACTED] demeanor and he told Deputy Prado that "If he wanted to end it all, he would have been done that already." [REDACTED] also recanted his statement about his gun getting stolen and claimed he gave the gun to [REDACTED]

Based upon the statements from [REDACTED] coupled with [REDACTED] acknowledgment that an incident did take place in his vehicle where he made concerning statements regarding his well being while in possession of a firearm, Deputy Prado determined there was a substantial likelihood that without care or treatment, [REDACTED] would cause serious bodily injury or even death to himself, as evidenced by his recent behavior. [REDACTED] was taken into protective custody under the provisions of the Baker Act and later transported to Halifax Hospital in Daytona Beach.

The Glock 23 pistol, 2 magazines, holster and 28 rounds of ammunition were seized for the purposes of completing of a Risk Protection Order.
