On 06/22/2026, at 0736 hours, Deputy Baba responded to _____, Deltona in reference to a Disturbance.

Upon arrival, Deputy Baba made contact with _____ (V2) who stated the following: _____ is the roommate of _____ and _____. In the morning hours of June 22nd, _____ was walking to his car when he observed _____ seated inside of her vehicle in the driveway and _____ standing next to the driver's window. _____ was observed with a firearm in his hand and _____ stated he proceeded to break the window with either his fist or the firearm. _____ began walking up to _____ and attempted to break up the altercation. Upon _____ approaching _____ proceeded to "pistol whip" _____ in the left side of the head which caused a laceration which drew blood. _____ then began physically fighting with _____. During the beginning of the physical altercation, _____ dropped the gun on the ground and continued physically fighting with _____. During the fight, _____ (R1) came outside after hearing the commotion and broke up the fight. After the fight was over, _____ picked up the firearm and placed it in the trash receptacle on the side of the home. _____ completed a sworn written statement testifying to the above information. Initially, _____ stated he wished to pursue charges but after _____ was secured, placed under arrest, and about to be transported away from the scene, _____ changed his mind and declined to pursue charges.

Deputy Baba made contact with _____ whose story matches that of _____. _____ only saw the ending of the physical confrontation and never saw _____ being "pistol whipped". _____ completed a sworn written statement testifying to her side of the events.

Deputy Baba made contact with _____ who advised the following: Herself and _____ began engaging in a verbal argument over infidelity issues in the morning hours of June 22nd. During the argument and located on the back patio, _____ grabbed a potted plant and propelled it in _____'s direction. The potted plant struck _____ in the eye, which caused bruising. _____ attempted to leave the residence and exited on to the driveway and entered her vehicle. _____ exited the residence, walked up to her car, and smashed the window with his hand. It is to be noted, at this point in the interview with _____, she began becoming uncooperative and refused to answer all questions requested of her. Furthermore, _____ refused to sign any Domestic Violence related paperwork or provide a sworn verbal or written statement.

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AFFIDAVIT CONTINUATION

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Deputies from patrol and the VSO K-9 Unit established a perimeter around the residence. [REDACTED] eventually exited the home peacefully. He was detained, placed in handcuffs, and read a Warning of Constitutional Rights from an agency-issued Miranda card. [REDACTED] stated he understood his rights and agreed to speak with deputies. [REDACTED] advised that he and [REDACTED] argued over infidelity issues earlier that morning. During the argument, he threw a potted plant in [REDACTED]'s direction but claimed he did not intend to hit her. After [REDACTED] went to her vehicle, [REDACTED] approached and broke the driver's side window. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] then approached him, and [REDACTED] felt the need to defend himself. According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] struck him multiple times. [REDACTED] stated he could not recall whether he produced the firearm before or after [REDACTED] began striking him but admitted to pulling the firearm and striking [REDACTED] multiple times with it. During the fight, [REDACTED] dropped the firearm. [REDACTED] then exited the residence and separated them. [REDACTED] reported handing the firearm's magazine to [REDACTED] before walking away from the driveway area. Deputies noted a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from [REDACTED]'s breath, and [REDACTED] admitted to consuming alcohol earlier that morning.

Deputy Baba documented injuries to all involved parties as follows/ [REDACTED] No observable injuries / [REDACTED] Bruising around the left eye / [REDACTED] Laceration to the left rear portion of the head / [REDACTED] No observable injuries / [REDACTED] was treated on scene by Deltona Fire/EMS and declined transport. [REDACTED] refused evaluation by EMS. Photographs of [REDACTED]'s injuries and the scene were taken and submitted to Evidence.com via Axon Capture. [REDACTED] refused to be photographed. Deputies recovered a teal Glock 43X from a trash receptacle outside the residence. The firearm was secured and submitted to the District Four evidence locker as case evidence.

Based on the observable injuries, statements from involved parties, and recovery of the firearm, Deputy Baba determined probable cause existed for the arrest of [REDACTED] for the following charges: • Aggravated Battery with a Deadly Weapon • Battery (Domestic Violence)

Due to the use of a firearm during the incident, a Risk Protection Order was completed and submitted for review. [REDACTED] was placed under arrest and transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail for further processing.

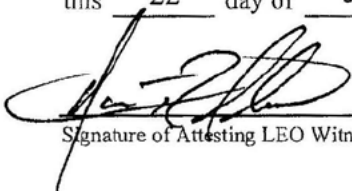
