AFFIDAVIT

I, {full legal name} D/S Brittney Battista #9760, in my position as {job title} Deputy Sheriff with the {name of law enforcement officer/agency} Volusia Sheriff's Office, swear and affirm that the following facts are true and correct.

1. {Name of Respondent} [REDACTED] poses a significant danger of causing personal injury to himself/herself or others by having a firearm or any ammunition in his/her custody or control or by purchasing, possessing or receiving a firearm or any ammunition. The following specific statements, actions, or facts give rise to a reasonable fear of significant dangerous acts by the respondent:

On 6/21/2026, at approximately 1457 hours Deputies were dispatched to [REDACTED] Deltona in reference to a disturbance. The reporting party stated her daughter was just dropped off by a male that they believe is an adult and they were in a verbal argument with the male.

Upon arrival, Deputies spoke to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] who advised their daughter [REDACTED] was gone all night and was just dropped off by a boy. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] believed the boy who dropped her off was not the boy she was with all night and believed she was with an older male who 18 years. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] did not mention anything physical occurring and stated the male left.

At approximately 1554 hours, Deputies were once again dispatched to [REDACTED], however the reporting party was [REDACTED] who advised her son [REDACTED] was assaulted at the address. Deputies met [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] Saxon Boulevard, Deltona.

[REDACTED] advised that he picked up a friend [REDACTED] from her residence on 6/20/2026, and the two went to a party in Ocoee. After the party was over [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] went to the beach for about 10-15 minutes before returning to his house in Orange City. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] hung out until he dropped her off at her house at [REDACTED]. As soon as [REDACTED] pulled into the driveway [REDACTED] got out of his car and went inside.

As [REDACTED] 2026, Toyota, Camry was parked in the driveway a white van blocked him in. [REDACTED] who is [REDACTED] stepfather exited the van and began to yell at [REDACTED] rolled down his window to try to tell him that he was just dropping [REDACTED] off. When [REDACTED] exited the van, he had a black, metal pipe similar to a baton in his hand. Once [REDACTED] rolled down his window [REDACTED] began to hit the roof of his car above the driver's side window. [REDACTED] also had a curved black knife in the other hand. [REDACTED] took the knife and held the knife near [REDACTED] neck. While [REDACTED] was yelling at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was at the front of the car yelling and waving a small, black handgun.

[REDACTED] described the handgun as an orange, and blue design on the handgun. [REDACTED] advised that he then exited and unlocked his door and [REDACTED] brother opened the door. [REDACTED] exited the vehicle and stated he was going to call his friend. Once out of the vehicle [REDACTED] was kicked in the upper thigh by a male neighbor. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] stepfather then moved his van and [REDACTED] was able to leave.

[REDACTED] contacted his brother who told him to call his mother. [REDACTED] advised that during the incident he was in fear for his life when [REDACTED] was waving the gun at him and while [REDACTED] held the knife to his neck.

Deputies spoke to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] about the incident, and they denied anything physical occurring. [REDACTED] advised she did have a firearm and showed it to deputies. The firearm owned by [REDACTED] was similar to the one [REDACTED] described. [REDACTED] firearm was small with a pink, white and black design on it.

Deputies observed several dents to the roof of [REDACTED] car which were consistent with something hitting it with a metal object.

[REDACTED] advised that she believes the damage to the car to be around \$4,000. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] advised they wish to press charges.

Based on the statements provided by [REDACTED] the damage and the firearm owned by [REDACTED] matching the description [REDACTED] gave it was determined that probable cause existed to charge [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] with the appropriate charges.

A criminal history check was conducted on [REDACTED] which revealed she did not have a criminal history.

[REDACTED] completed a sworn written statement indicating he wishes to press charges. [REDACTED] completed a Marsy's law form for [REDACTED] indicating she wishes to keep his information private.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were transported to the Volusia County Branch jail without incident. [REDACTED] was taken to the Family Resource Center due to her not having a guardian to watch her.

DCF and Director Quann were both notified of the incident.

At this time the neighbor who kicked [REDACTED] has not been identified, follow up will be conducted by Deputy Battista to identify the neighbor. Based on the investigation [REDACTED] brother did not commit any crimes and was not charged.
