

COURSE: This course is based on the premise that the primary objective of the basic first recruit First Aid instructor is to teach recruits their responsibilities for safe and effective response to an emergency medical situation.

STUDENTS SHOULD BRING: Note taking materials, textbook will be provided by The Academy.

ATTIRE: Business Casual (No shorts or jeans)

NOTES: This competency-based course may be completed in less than the scheduled hours if all objectives, content, exercises, proficiency evaluations, and exams are met (Rule 11B-35.001, F.A.C.). Students in a Specialized Instructor Course must pass the written exam on their first attempt with a minimum score of 85% and demonstrate all required proficiency skills in accordance with CJSTC rules; First Aid Instructor students must show 100% proficiency in all specified skills (Rule 11B-35.0024, F.A.C.).

- •Identify the components of the Florida Basic Recruit Training Program
- •Identify legal, ethical and liability issues associated with first aid training
- •Demonstrate how to teach a lesson from the CMS First Aid for Criminal Justice Officer Basic Recruit Curriculum
- Demonstrate how to assemble and manage first aid practical and scenario exercises
- Demonstrate proper evaluation technique of first aid practical and scenario exercises
