No prerequisites required.

COURSE: The student will be refreshed on their duties and responsibilities at the scene of a crash. The student will learn how to identify evidence found on the roadway and from the vehicle. An introduction to some of the important mathematical calculations and physical laws will be given. Also, the student will learn how to measure and diagram, and how to use photography and video to document the scene. The student will also participate in practical exercises involving measuring and diagramming.

All students must pass a final written exam with a minimum score of 80%. Attendance is mandatory for all sessions of this course.

Course Topics Include:

- Physical evidence from the roadway
- Physical evidence from the vehicle
- Frictional forces & acceleration
- Determining speeds from skid mark evidence
- Crash scene photography
- Methods of measuring crash scenes
- Diagramming scenes & use of traffic templates
- Case preparation
